Policy on Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking

The Trust commits to respect employees, paid interns and self employed consultants in the workplace. This commitment includes its full support to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and efforts to promote ethical principles and practices related to the prevention, exploitation and abuse associated with modern slavery and human trafficking.

The Trust similarly expects commitment to these principles from its supply chain and will not support nor do business with suppliers knowingly involved in slavery or human trafficking.

The Trust's values are that everyone should expect to be treated with dignity and have decent working and employment conditions. This includes employees and self employed consultants {though not unpaid interns and work experience pupils who are visitors, not employed) earning pay that is not below the minimum wage for the country in which they are employed. We will ensure fairness in recruitment of all employees, both permanent and temporary, without discrimination. All of our employees have a personal responsibility for maintaining a respectful work atmosphere, free of abusive or unprofessional conduct.
